A CLASSICAL, CHRISTIAN APPROACH

A classical, Christian education is an approach to education that combines the traditional liberal arts curriculum of a classical education with a Christian worldview. The primary goal of this approach is to form the whole person, developing not only their intellect but also their character and virtue. This is accomplished by focusing on the study of grammar, logic, rhetoric, mathematics, the natural sciences, and by integrating biblical principles into the curriculum.

One key component of a classical education is the Trivium, which is a method of teaching that emphasizes the importance of mastering basic factual content, understanding how to apply it, and synthesizing information into an articulate expression or argument. This progression allows students to think critically and make informed decisions, which is essential in today's complex and rapidly changing world.

Another important aspect of a classical, Christian education is the integration of subjects. A PARTNERSHIP WITH PARENTS

At Vintage Christian Academy, we believe in the importance of a collaborative approach to education that emphasizes the role of the parents in their children's education. We understand that parents are the primary influence in their children's lives, and we strive to redirect time from school to the family. Our different offerings allow families to choose what is best for their family and take

back control of their schedules. We also encourage and expect parents to be actively involved as a key part of their child's education. We believe the two institutions ordained by God to educate children are the family and the church. Our school is designed to engage both of these to educate children the way God intended.

School Board & Leadership

Leading the school's administration is the Head of School, who leads the staff and faculty and is supported by the School Board.

Comprising 14 members, the board members are chosen based on their expertise and commitment to the school. Their terms of service are reviewed on an annual basis. Composed of individuals with a range of expertise and specializations, the School Board serves to carry and protect the culture within the organization, assist in solving problems, and advise the Head of School on various matters related to the school's operations and mission.

CLASSICAL CORE:

Monday, Wednesday, & Friday • 8:00am - 3:00pm Pre-K4 to 6th Grade

This program provides a rigorous, classical education that is designed to help students develop the skills and knowledge they need to succeed in all areas of their lives. Our Classical Core program is based on the classical model of education, which emphasizes the development of critical thinking skills, the study of great books and ideas, and the acquisition of knowledge in a variety of subjects.

ENRICHMENT DAYS:

Tuesday & Thursday • 8:00am - 3:00pm Pre-K4 to 6th Grade

This program is an optional add-on to our Classical Core program and provides a full-time alternative for families, although homeschool students can enroll seperately. It is designed to provide additional enrichment in subjects that help provide a deeper range of knowledge. Our Enrichment Days program includes a variety of activities and classes that are designed to challenge and engage students and to help them develop their skills and knowledge in a variety of areas. Our enrichment days also include guided study time that allows students access to their teachers to assist in any subjects' course load.

As members of the Vanguard, we pledge to uphold the following standards of behavior and excellence:

Integrity:

Proverbs 11:3 NLT states, "The integrity of the upright guides them, but the unfaithful are destroyed by their duplicity." We will be honest in our words and actions, and strive to do the right thing even if no one is looking.

Respect:

Ephesians 4:29 NLT commands us to, "Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen." We will treat all individuals with dignity and honor, and refrain from any form of bullying or disrespect.

Diligence:

Proverbs 12:24 NLT states, "Work hard and become a leader; be lazy and become a slave." We will put forth our best effort in our academic pursuits, and strive for excellence in all that we do.

Responsibility:

Colossians 3:23-24 says, "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving." We understand that our time at Vintage Christian Academy is a privilege and we will be responsible for our own learning and development.

Humility:

James 4:6 NLT reminds us, "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble." We will strive to maintain a humble attitude, recognizing that our abilities and achievements are gifts from God.

Service:

Philippians 2:3-4 NLT commands us to, "Do nothing out of rivalry or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than yourselves. Everyone should look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others." We will actively look for opportunities to serve others, both within and outside of our school community.

Community:

Hebrews 10:24-25 NLT instructs us to, "Let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching." We will actively seek to build and maintain strong relationships within our school community, and participate in school functions.

It is important to note that growth and change are a process, and we understand that mistakes may be made. If a student is found to have violated the honor code, the expectation is that they will take responsibility for their actions, show genuine remorse and a desire to do better in the future. Through God's grace, we will work together to help the student grow and mature in their understanding and adherence to the honor code.







STATEMENTS ON FAITH, LIFE, & CONDUCT

As a Christian institution, Vintage Christian Academy is committed to upholding the core beliefs and values that are essential to the collaboration between home, church, and school. To ensure unity within our community, we have outlined our beliefs, understandings, and expectations in our Statements on Faith, Life, and Conduct.

These statements include the following core elements of the Christian faith that we believe and profess:

The Bible

We believe the entire Bible is the inspired, infallible, authoritative Word of God and should be the supreme and final authority in our lives and faith.

One God

We believe in one God who exists and reveals Himself in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and is the creator of all things seen and unseen.

Jesus Christ

We believe Jesus Christ is God the son, the second person of the trinity. He was born of the Virgin Mary, lived a sinless life, performed many miracles and died on a cross for our sins. He was raised from the dead on the third day in accordance with scriptures, ascended to heaven where he is at the right hand of the Father, and will return again to establish his eternal rule as King over the new heavens and new earth.

Humanity

We believe God created humanity, male and female, in the image and likeness of God. We believe life begins at conception and that our gender and sexuality are good gifts from God and likewise determined by God from conception. We believe every life is sacred because God is the originator of every life. We believe that sin separated man from God. Despite sin and separation, we believe all humans, male and female, from every tongue, tribe, and nation, are valuable to God, deserving of love and respect, and should be afforded the opportunity of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Salvation

We believe that salvation is offered by grace through faith in accordance with repentance and belief in the death, burial, resurrection, and reality of Jesus Christ. His shed blood for our sins and resurrection from the dead means that we can we be forgiven and restored into fellowship with God.

The Church

We believe that the Church is comprised of all those who acknowledge Jesus as Lord and Savior, and that scripture instructs believers to identify and regularly assemble with other believers to devote themselves to worship, prayer, teaching of the Bible, fellowship, and works of service.

The Holy Spirit

We believe the Holy Spirit is the third person of the godhead, and at the point of salvation the Holy Spirit fills each believer as a down payment of salvation to be a source of strength, assurance, and wisdom for daily life.

The Infilling of the Holy Spirit

We believe in a subsequent experience where the Holy Spirit fills a believer to overflowing and is empowered to preach the gospel with boldness and operate in spiritual gifts.

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit

We believe the Holy Spirit has supernatural gifts to distribute to Christians for the instruction and empowering of every believer to demonstrate the power, reality and supremacy of God to the world. All believers are commanded to earnestly desire the gifts of the spirit. These gifts always operate in harmony with the Scriptures and when operated with balance and order, these gifts will bring glory to God and the light of truth to the lost.

Water Baptism

We believe all believers should obey Jesus in water baptism, by immersion, in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We believe baptism is both a public profession of their faith in Christ as well as a spiritual sacrament where the old man is buried with Christ and a new man is raised to life.

Eternity & Second Coming of Christ

We believe in the personal and imminent return of our Lord Jesus Christ and in the bodily resurrection of all people unto judgment. This judgment will bring everlasting life in the new earth for the saved and the punishment of hell and eternal separation from God for the lost.

Communion


We believe that the holy ordinance of Communion should be received regularly by believers walking in fellowship with the Lord Jesus Christ as a remembrance and celebration of what the broken body and shed blood of Christ accomplished for them on the cross.

Biblical Marriage

We believe marriage is a covenant relationship between God, one man and one woman, for life for the purposes of mission, companionship, procreation and demonstration of Christ's relationship with the Church. The Bible limits the expression of human sexuality to a marital relationship between a man and a woman, which is the only legitimate and acceptable sexual relationship according to scripture. All sexual activity apart from this context should be abstained from.

Tithing & Giving

We believe that Christians are called to be generous givers and to trust God with their finances. We believe the starting place for Christian giving is to return the first tenth of their income back to their local church as a way of honoring God and recognizing Him as first in their aofferings and is the foundation of biblical stewardship. We believe all tithes and offerings should be given cheerfully, out of obedience and in response to God's word and God's goodness towards us.

FREQUENTY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What grades does Vintage Christian Academy offer?

A: Currently, Vintage Christian Academy offers Pre-K to 6th grade, including our Mother's Day Out program for preschoolers and our Classical Core program for Pre-K4 to 6th grade students. We also offer optional Enrichment Days for students in Pre-K4 to 6th grade, which provide additional academic and enrichment opportunities. In the future, we plan to expand to 7-8th and 9-12th grades, as well as offer summer camps and before and after school programs.

Q: Is Vintage Christian Academy accredited?

A: VCA is going through the process of becoming accredited by the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI) as well as Association of Classical Christian Schools. ACSI and ACCS are national accrediting agencies that recognize Christian schools that meet high standards of academic excellence, education philosophy, and Christian worldview.

Q: What is the student-teacher ratio at VCA?

A: We strive to keep our class sizes small, with a student-teacher ratio of no more than 15:1.

Q: What is the admissions process at Vintage Christian Academy?

A: The admissions process at Vintage Christian Academy consists of several steps. First, families must submit an application online, which includes student records, a written explanation of why they wish to enroll, a statement of family belief, and an affirmation of VCA values. Next, families must provide a written recommendation from their pastor or elder (or a reference for us to contact) and participate in a family interview with the head of school and a pastor on the church executive team. Students may also be required to take a placement test, which will be reviewed after the interview. After the application process is complete, the pastor and head of school will submit their recommendation to the school board, and acceptance will be based on a simple majority vote. However, either the pastor or head of school has veto power over a particular family/student.

Q: Does Vintage Christian Academy require uniforms?

A: Yes, uniforms are required. You can find out more about our uniform policy at *vintage.academy*.

Q: Does VCA offer financial aid or scholarships?

A: Yes, we offer financial aid and scholarships to families in need. Please contact our admissions office for more information.

Q: What is the policy on electronics at Vintage Christian Academy?

A: Vintage Christian Academy has a policy on electronics that is intended to promote focus, respect, and safety. Students are generally not allowed to bring electronic devices to school, except in certain circumstances with prior approval. Please see our handbook for more information on our electronics policy.

Q: Are students in one of the Pre-K4 to 6th grade programs required to enroll in the other?

A: No, families may choose to enroll their students in whichever programs are best for them. They may enroll in either or both Pre-K4 to 6th grade programs at their own discretion.

Q: What does the placement testing include?

A: Placement tests include reading, writing, and math.

Q: Can my student who has never been schooled classically keep up?

A: Yes, our program is designed to allow all students to succeed regardless of where they started.
